## Reports:

## **Superintendent/Grade School Principal's Report:**

- One of the weight room pieces came in and the students and some of the staff are very excited about it. I am going to get more weights for the leg sled with the boards approval.

- Down in the grade school special ed room there is a problem with the steam pipe. It appears to have busted. We are looking into the insurance and getting that fixed.
